

PRIVACY POLICY

§ 1

Glossary of terms

Whenever the following defined terms appear in this Policy, they shall be understood as follows.

following:

1. Registration Form - the form used to register Participants for the Hackathon, available on the Event website:
2. Policy - this Privacy Policy defines the rules of processing personal data for the event named "ETHWarsaw Conference & Hackathon" taking place on September 1-4, 2022.
3. Terms and Conditions - the Hackathon Rules and Regulations, setting out the terms and conditions of the "ETHWarsaw Conference & Hackathon" competition, available at: GDPR - Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).
4. Participant - an adult natural person with full legal capacity who has properly registered for the Hackathon and received confirmation of participation.
5. Event - the event named "ETHWarsaw Conference & Hackathon" takes place on September 1-4, 2022, at Warsaw University of Technology, at Plac Politechniki 1.

§ 2

Purposes and legal basis of personal data processing

1. The Administrator processes the following personal data of Participants indicated in the Application Form: name, surname, e-mail address, contact telephone, mailing address, ETH wallet address, GitHub account address, information indicated by the Participant regarding motivation to take part in the Hackathon, experience with Web3 (verbal) and knowledge of "crypto" (specified by points).
2. The Administrator shall process personal data recorded audiovisually during the Event, including in particular the image and voice, on the terms and for the purposes provided for in § 9 paragraphs 5-9 of the Regulations.
3. Provision of data by the Participant in the form of the following areas: from which country he/she comes, in which other Hackathons he/she participated is voluntary, but necessary if the Participant wants this information to be included in the descriptions of him, and his team.
4. Provision of data by the Participant in the form with regard to his/her affiliation with a team is voluntary, but necessary if he/she has already joined one and will participate in it at the Hackathon.
5. Personal data of Participants indicated in the Registration Form shall be processed by the Administrator for the following purposes:

- a) registration and operation of the Event, to the extent indicated in paragraph 1 above - on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) GDPR;
 - b) operation of the Event, to the extent indicated in paragraph 2 above - on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR;
 - c) accounting and financial reporting, within the scope of fulfilling the Organizer's legal obligations - on the basis of Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR;
 - d) ongoing mutual contacts and investigation or defense against possible claims arising from the Participant's participation in the Event - on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.
6. The Participants' personal data is processed by the Administrator for marketing purposes based on the Participant's consent expressed in this regard - on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

§ 3

Source of data

The Administrator processes the Participants' personal data in terms of images and voice recorded during the Event, and as the case may be:

- (a) indicated by the Participant in the Application Form of the Event,
- (b) provided by the persons registering the Team in the Application Form.

§ 5

Processing period and rights related to data processing

1. The period of data processing shall be determined based on the existing purpose of processing. The period of data processing may result from the provisions of law, when they are the basis for processing. If the processing of data is based on the legitimate interest of the Organizer - the data are processed for a period that allows the realization of this interest or the filing of an effective objection to data processing. If the basis for processing is the necessity to conclude and perform a contract, the data are processed until the termination of the contract and the expiration of the period for the investigation or defense against claims.
2. In the case of data processed on the basis of the Participant's consent, personal data covered by such consent shall be processed until the consent is withdrawn or the purpose of the processing ceases. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
3. Consent to the processing of personal data, the Participant may withdraw at any time by notifying the email address: hello@ethwarsaw.dev. The Participant may also use this address for any requests related to the exercise of the rights referred to in paragraph 4 regarding the data processed by the Administrator.
4. The person whose data is processed has the right to: access to their data, rectification and deletion of their data, restriction of their processing, right to data portability, not to be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling. The participant also has the right to object to the processing of his/her personal data and

to withdraw his/her consent to their processing, if the sole basis for their processing was the previously expressed consent.

5. The participant has the right to file a complaint in connection with the processing of his personal data to the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
6. Provision of data for the purposes of participation in the Event is voluntary, however, necessary to participate in the Event.

§ 6

Transfer of personal data to third countries

The Administrator transfers data outside the European Economic Area only when necessary and with an adequate degree of protection. We ensure that the agreed standard contractual clauses adopted by the European Commission as part of the screening procedure are the basis for the data transfer each time.

§ 7

Recipients of personal data

1. The Administrator may share Participants' personal data with:
 - (a) entities supporting the Administrator in the organization of the Event, e.g.: advisors, entities providing technical support, entities responsible for e-mail and website maintenance, and other entities providing the technical infrastructure of the Event,
 - (b) public authorities fighting fraud and abuse, and other entities, if required by mandatory provisions of law.
2. Recipients of the data may be entities offering solutions for mass emailing, collection of requests and entities providing IT support.

§ 8

Amendment of the Policy

1. This Policy may be amended or updated to reflect changes occurring in the way personal data are processed or changes in applicable law. The Administrator reserves the right to make changes to the Privacy Policy if required by law, changes made to <https://www.ethwarsaw.dev/> or changes in the organization and conduct of the Event.
2. The Regulations shall come into force on 01.09.2022.
